## Frequently Asked Questions

### Seabeck Kedjiwaan Gathering 9/11 – 9/14, 2025

#### Q – Are some rooms with private baths still available?

A – **YES** – Friday and Saturday lodging in Spruce Building! Register here **by 9/1**:

#### Q – When does event registration close?

A – Registration is extended through **September 1<sup>st</sup>**.

#### Q - When can I check in?

A – Room assignments and lodging keys will be available at the Subud Check-In at 4pm Thursday, Friday & Saturday. Check-in will be at or near the Historic Inn.

#### Q – Do we have a Covid/Flu prevention plan?

A – **Yes. Please do a home test for Covid/Flu before you leave for Seabeck. This will help eliminate sharing any virus like happened with the California Congress.**

#### Q - When does the Gathering end on Sunday?

A – Gathering ends with lunch Sunday. Keys should be returned by 1:00pm.

#### Q -Can I park at the building where I'm staying and drive between buildings?

A. – Yes. There is parking near each building.

#### Q - If I can't attend but want to help others attend, how do I donate?
